

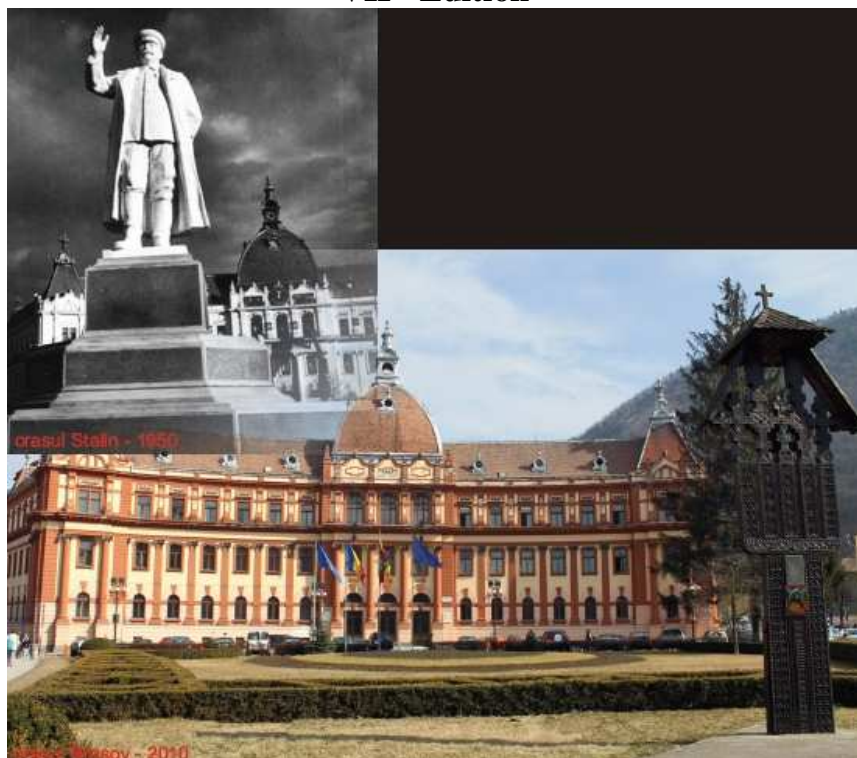

	<p>The workshop, organized in 3 sessions, as round table, debates, visits, communications, targets:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Better knowing the Stalinist period by the youth in order to make them reflect on the illegitimate and criminal character of the communist regime from the East-European space; - Knowing the recent past leads to thoroughly comprehending the present realities and the necessity of observing the human rights and the lawful status, the social cohesion under the conditions of the equality in chances and of the elimination of the discriminations, whatsoever their nature, on nationality, language religion, sex, race and handicap criteria. <p>Such an approach can be of great usefulness and application, in a world not thoroughly devoid of extremist practices. Comprehending the totalitarian economic, political and social systems: Nazism and Stalinism, whereon youth have limited information, is a necessity at present, in order to appreciate the European Union's overall value, underlain by fundamental values, such as freedom, democracy and the observance of the human rights.</p>
